TREFNIADAU DECHRAU'R TYMOR NEWYDD

Yn dilyn llythyr gan Weinidog y Gymraeg ac Addysg ddoe, hoffwn rannu gwybodaeth bellach gyda chi am drefniadau dychwelyd yr Ysgol ym mis Ionawr. **Mae hyn yn wahanol i'r trefniadau a rannwyd gyda chi dros y penwythnos.**

Yn sgil yr ansicrwydd am effaith amrywiolyn newydd Covid-19, **ni fydd disgyblion yn mynychu'r ysgol ar ddau ddiwrnod cyntaf y tymor ar ôl yr HMS ar Ddydd Mawrth 4 Ionawr. Bydd Dydd Mercher 5 Ionawr a Dydd Iau 6 Ionawr yn ddiwrnodau paratoi.**

Newidiadau Lefel Risg Uchel

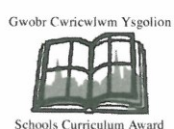

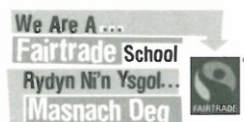
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- gwersi rhithiol yn unig ar draws y Bartneriaeth yn y Chweched Dosbarth ar ddechrau Ionawr.

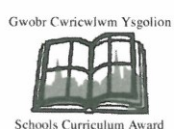

ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE NEW TERM

Following a letter from the Minister for Education yesterday, I would like to share with you further information about the arrangements for our return to School in January. **This is different from the arrangements we shared with you over the weekend.**

Due to uncertainty over the impact of the new Covid-19 variant, **pupils will not be attending school on the first two days of term** after INSET on **Tuesday 4 January**. **Wednesday 5 January** and **Thursday 6 January** will be preparation days.

Year 11, 12 and 13 pupils are expected to return to school on Friday 7 January, and the **whole school on Monday 10 January**. Should there be any change to the above arrangements over the Christmas holidays, we will let you know as soon as possible.

The 'preparation days' are intended to be used for:

- assessing staffing capacity;
- preparing for a 'high risk level' return;
- put in place necessary measures to support learners' return;
- prepare for the move to distance learning, if necessary with specific groups of pupils.
- prioritise provision for examination years to continue face-to-face learning;
- put plans in place so that some of our learners can continue to take their January exams safely;
- prepare provision for vulnerable pupils and children of key workers.

High Risk Level Changes

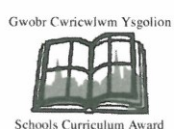
Ysgol Gyfun Gŵyr has continued to implement a number of measures to reduce the spread of the virus since the beginning of term. In January, we will be expected to implement the following in line with the Local Decision Framework and the school's risk assessment:

- masks to be worn in populated areas and in lessons;
- separation of contact groups of pupils;
- distance learning across the Partnership in the Sixth Form at the beginning of January.
- staggered departure times at the end of the day.
- postponement of after-school clubs and team games for the time being.

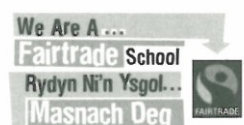
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LFD TESTS

Pupils and school staff are expected to take 3 LFD tests weekly (on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays) to identify any asymptomatic causes. This to start next **Monday, 20 December**.

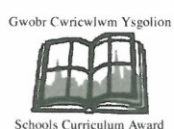
