
Ysgrifennaf atoch mewn perthynas â'r trefniadau ailagor ysgolion ym mis Ionawr 2021. Yn anffodus, mae'r sefyllfa bresennol o ran trosglwyddiad Covid-19 ledled Cymru yn ei gwneud yn anodd iawn i ni ragweld yr effaith y bydd yn ei chael ar lefelau staffio yn ein hysgolion yn dilyn gwyliau'r Nadolig. Ein blaenoriaeth yw lleihau'r tarfu ar addysg ein plant a'n pobl ifanc gymaint â phosibl. Fodd bynnag, rydym yn cydnabod y bydd angen i ysgolion adolygu eu lefelau staffio ar ddechrau'r tymor newydd ac o ganlyniad bydd angen rhywfaint o hyblygrwydd yn dibynnu ar amgylchiadau lleol.

O ganlyniad, bydd pob ysgol yn Abertawe ar gau i blant ar y 4ydd a 5ed o Ionawr. Efallai mai dim ond ychydig o ddisbarthiadau all ddychwelyd, a bydd rhai disgyblion yn derbyn eu haddysg o bell. Bydd cymorth ar y safle ar gael i blant gweithwyr allweddol a dysgwyr bregus; fodd bynnag, fel o'r blaen dim ond pan fydd holl opsiynau eraill wedi'u hystyried y dylid defnyddio'r gwasanaeth hwn. Mae hyn er mwyn diogelu lles disgyblion a staff yn yr ysgolion. Cysylltwch â'ch ysgol i gael rhagor o wybodaeth.

Rwy'n gobeithio y bydd y wybodaeth hon yn rhoi rhywfaint o eglurder i chi ar ddychwelyd i'r ysgol, fodd bynnag, bydd eich ysgol yn gallu rhoi rhagor o wybodaeth i chi ddechrau mis Ionawr. Dear Parent/ Carer

I am writing to you in relation to the re-opening arrangements for schools in January 2021. Unfortunately, the current situation with the increasing transmission of Covid-19 across Wales makes it very difficult for us to predict the impact it will have on staffing levels in our schools following the Christmas break.

Our priority is to minimise disruption to our children and young people's education as much as possible. However, we recognise that schools will need to assess their staffing levels at the beginning of the new term and as a result some flexibility will be required depending on local circumstances.

As a result, all schools in Swansea will be closed to pupils on 4th and 5th January. This will allow school to assess levels of staff availability, to review all risk assessments and to consider any further requirements in relation to the planning of the spring term. Your school will contact you to confirm arrangements from 6th January onwards but it is expected that most schools will be able to welcome all pupils back by 11th January if circumstances allow.

It may be that only a few classes can return, and some pupils will receive their education remotely. Onsite support will be available for children of critical workers and vulnerable learners; however, as before this service must only be used where all other options have been exhausted. This is to protect the wellbeing of pupils and staff in the schools. Please contact your school for further information.

I hope this information provides you with some clarity on the return to school, however, your school will be able to give you further information at the start of January. I know this term has not been easy and I would like to thank you for your continued co-operation and support. It is vital we do all we can to try and reduce the spread of the virus, and we must continue to follow the guidance to protect both ourselves and others. I wish you and your family a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.
