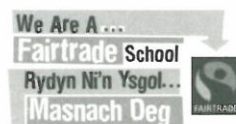

School Uniform

As we prepare for the new academic year, we would like to share an update regarding our school uniform following our recent Learner, Staff, Parent and Governor Voice surveys. Having carefully considered all the views shared, we have decided to retain our current school uniform. The feedback showed a clear consensus that a smart, practical and inclusive uniform promotes pride, a sense of belonging and equality across our school community. A consistent message that also emerged from the feedback was the need to apply our school uniform expectations more consistently to ensure fairness, inclusion and high standards for all pupils. Whilst we recognise the importance of pupils feeling comfortable, we also believe that wearing the school uniform correctly contributes to a positive learning environment.

We would therefore be grateful for your support in ensuring that all pupils adhere to the following expectations:

- **Plain black shoes or completely black trainers only** (no coloured stripes/white soles to them).
- **The school jumper or the official school hoodie only.**
- **Black school trousers or skirt** (No joggers)
- **A blue school polo shirt with the school badge.**
- **Make-up, jewellery and hairstyles** should be appropriate for school and should not be extreme.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us ensure that these expectations are applied fairly, consistently and for the benefit of all pupils.

End of Year Arrangements

Term will finish for learners on **Friday 17 July**. On that day, after lunch at school, buses will arrive at **12.45pm** to collect learners and take them home. Before departing, pupils will spend time with their form tutors before attending a whole-school assembly to celebrate another successful year.
